NOTIFICATION OF NATIONAL DEFINITION OF HAZARDOUS WASTES PURSUANT
TO ARTICLE 3 OF THE BASEL CONVENTION
MEXICO

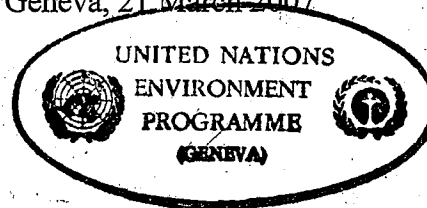
Pursuant to article 3 of the Basel Convention, the Secretariat informs Parties that the United Mexican States transmitted communications dated 22 January 2007 and 2 March 2007 to the Secretariat concerning its national definition of wastes, other than those listed in Annexes I, II and VIII of the Basel Convention, considered or defined as hazardous under its national legislation and requirements concerning transboundary movement procedures applicable to such wastes.

The United Mexican States advises that the hazardous wastes mentioned in its national legislation are those wastes indicated in Article 31 of La Ley General para la Prevención y Gestión Integral de los Residuos (LGPGIR), NOM-004-SEMARNAT-2002, NOM-052-SEMARNAT-2005, NOM-087-SEMARNAT-SSA1-2002, NOM-133-SEMARNAT-2000 and NOM-141-SEMARNAT-2003 and copies of these are contained in Attachment 1 of the communication. The requirements concerning the transboundary movements of such wastes are contained in Attachment 2.
