4. Request for information on POPs wastes technical guidelines

<u>Decision</u>: BC-12/3: Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with persistent organic pollutants

Background:

In accordance with decision BC-11/3, the Conference of the Parties decided to update the general technical guidelines for the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with persistent organic pollutants and decided to prepare or update specific technical guidelines concerning POPs, in consultation with the small intersessional working group, for consideration by the Open-ended Working Group at its ninth meeting, and subsequently by the Conference of the Parties at it twelfth meeting.

At its twelfth meeting, in decision BC-12/3, the Conference of the Parties adopted the technical guidelines listed below, which concern persistent organic pollutants. Additionally, the Conference of the Parties agreed on some follow-up activities/requests that are described below:

- General technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with persistent organic pollutants;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with perfluorooctane sulfonic acid, its salts and perfluorooctane sulfonyl fluoride;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes containing or contaminated with unintentionally produced hexachlorobenzene, pentachlorobenzene, polychlorinated biphenyls, polychlorinated dibenzofurans or polychlorinated dibenzo-p-dioxins;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with hexabromobiphenyl, polybrominated biphenyls, polychlorinated biphenyls or polychlorinated terphenyls;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with hexabromodiphenyl ether and heptabromodiphenyl ether, or tetrabromodiphenyl ether and pentabromodiphenyl ether;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with hexabromocyclododecane;
- Technical guidelines on the environmentally sound management of wastes consisting of, containing or contaminated with pesticides aldrin, alpha hexachlorocyclohexane, beta hexachlorocyclohexane, chlordane, chlordecone, dieldrin, endrin, heptachlor, hexachlorobenzene, lindane, mirex, pentachlorobenzene, perfluorocatane sulfonic acid, technical endosulfan and its related isomers or toxaphene or with hexachlorobenzene as an industrial chemical.
