## 8. Request for information related to national legislation, notifications, enforcement of the Convention and efforts to combat illegal traffic

Mandate: BC-12/8: National legislation, notifications, enforcement of the Convention and efforts to

combat illegal traffic

## Background:

This decision builds on similar decisions adopted in the past, the latest being decision BC-11/8. The decision contains routine requests for information from parties on their national legislation, national definitions of hazardous wastes, import or export restrictions and prohibitions, as well as with respect to preventing and combating illegal traffic. The invitation for parties to provide the Secretariat with the texts of national legislation and other measures adopted by them to implement and enforce the Convention is similar to the one set out in paragraph 17 of decision BC-12/7: Committee for Administering the Mechanism for Promoting Implementation and Compliance of the Basel Convention , whereby the Conference of the Parties reminded parties to share, through the Secretariat, texts of national legislation and other regulatory measures adopted by them to implement and enforce the provisions of the Basel Convention or to make use of the revised reporting format to transmit such texts to the Secretariat.
