

## 2. Invitations related to decision OEWG-10/2 on developing guidelines for environmentally sound management

Decision: OEWG-10/2: Developing guidelines for environmentally sound management

Background:

By decision BC-12/1 on follow-up to the Indonesian-Swiss country-led initiative to improve the effectiveness of the Basel Convention, the work programme of the expert working group on environmentally sound management was adopted. Since COP-12, the expert working group has continued its work to develop an ESM toolkit that includes practical manuals for the promotion of the environmentally sound management of wastes and fact sheets on specific waste streams.

The tenth meeting of the Open-ended Working Group expressed its appreciation to the expert working group and requested it to continue to develop activities, subject to the availability of resources, to implement its work programme.

Following an opportunity for comments by Parties and others, the expert working group has been requested to revise the set of draft practical manuals for the promotion of the environmentally sound management of wastes and the draft fact sheets on specific waste streams and to submit them for consideration and possible adoption by COP-13, and to revise the draft practical manuals on extended producer responsibility and financing systems for environmentally sound management and to submit them for consideration by COP-13.

Additionally, the Secretariat has been requested to develop an online survey to assess the relevance and utility of the Basel Convention documents related to environmentally sound management, and to prepare a report on the responses received from Parties and others for submission to COP-13
